
The company moved premises in 2013 from their family farm in Starbeck to a new bespoke site in Flaxby. This was to meet the growing demands on capacity and to improve logistics.

The company now grades, packs and distributes over 4 million eggs per week to retailers including Morrisons, Aldi and Booths.
